

# Residential Licence Information

(From November 2019)

*This licence lets accommodation providers such as motels sell liquor for consumption on and, in some circumstances, off the premises.*

## Existing licences

All existing residential licences and some special circumstances licences will be incorporated into the category.

## Key points about residential licences

Subject to the conditions of the licence, the category authorises the licensee to sell liquor:

- > to a resident for consumption on or off the premises
- > to a resident's guest for consumption on the licensed premises, as long as the resident is also present
- > for consumption on the premises before, during or after a meal
- > for consumption on the premises to a person:
  - attending a reception
  - attending a function at which food is provided
  - seated at a table.

The main service of the business must be accommodation for members of the public, except where allowed by a condition of the licence.

## Eligible businesses

Eligible businesses for this category of licence include accommodation providers.
